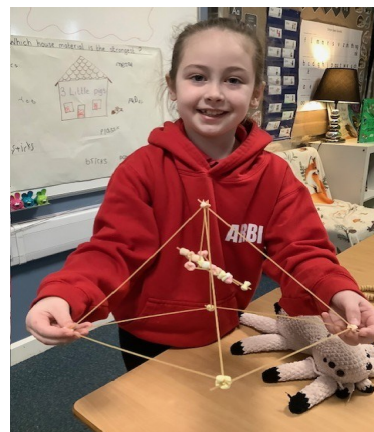


Breakfast Club
